Georgia has an incredibly rich culture, with unique styles of polyphonic singing, dance, poetry and myth. Georgian cuisine has been shaped by influences from Asia, Turkey and Persia, and offers a wonderfully diverse set of flavours, with delicious gastronomy and over 500 unique grape varieties not found elsewhere, as well as traditional winemaking techniques using clay pots called Qvevri.
